

## Judge Orders Conference on Ruby Case

DALLAS (UPI) — Judge Joe B. Brown Friday ordered a conference of prosecution and defense lawyers on Monday to discuss a sanity trial for condemned killer Jack Ruby.

Brown did not say if psychiatrists would be present. However, reports of state and defense psychiatrists, as well as a report by court-appointed psychiatrist Dr. Robert L. Stubblefield, will be available for consideration.

Brown, who presided at the trial of the slayer of accused Presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, said he might set a sanity trial date Monday. Such a trial would be held before a jury.
