## Dallas Bar Chief Becomes Fifth Ruby Defender

DALLAS (UPI) — Clayton Fowler, president of the Dallas Criminal Bar Assn., took over Tuesday as the fifth chief defense attorney for Jack Ruby.

Fowler, 43, said he was retained by the condemned slayer's brother, Earl, of Detroit, and Sol Dann, a Detroit lawyer who is Earl Ruby's legal adviser.

Fowler succeeds Tom Howard, Melvin Belli of San Francisco, Perry Foreman of Houston and Dr. Hubert Winston Smith of the University of Texas.
