

Lie-Detector Test Given to Ruby in Cell

DALLAS (UPI) — A member of the Warren Commission Saturday night gave condemned killer Jack Ruby a lie-detector test in his cell.

A representative of the commission investigating the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, said the test was administered at Ruby's request. He said results of the test would not be revealed immediately.

Defense attorneys Clayton Fowler of Dallas and Joe H. Tonahill of Jasper, Tex., were present in the cell along with Dr. William Beavers, a psychiatrist, a court reporter and a representative of Sheriff Bill Decker. Asst. Dist. Atty. William F. Alexander was present.
