

WARREN REPORT TO BE MADE PUBLIC SUNDAY

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Sunday, the White House said Tuesday. The findings of the Warren Commission investigation into the assassination of John F. Kennedy will be made public at 3:30 p.m. The report is estimated to run more than 250,000 words. President Johnson will

receive his copy of the report from Chief Justice Earl Warren and others on the seven-man commission Thursday at the White House.

The report will be placed on sale to the general public Monday morning at the Government Printing Office in Washington.
