

## **Report Goes on Sale In Washington Today**

WASHINGTON, Sept. 27—The Warren Commission's report on the assassination of President Kennedy is virtually guaranteed best-seller status among Government documents, officials predicted today.

The official document, "Report of the President's Commission on the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy," goes on sale at 8:30 tomorrow at the retail bookstore of the United States Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, 710 North Capitol Street, Washington 25, D. C.

A spokesman stressed that mail orders must include a return address and a check or money order for \$3.25 for the cloth-bound edition, or \$2.50 for the paperback.

At least four private publishers plan to duplicate the report for sale in bookstores and on paperback book racks at newsstands and drugstores.
