**Oswald Widow
to Enroll at
U of Michigan**

ANN ARBOR, Mich. (UPI) — Mrs. Marina Oswald, widow of President John F. Kennedy's assassin, will enroll at the University of Michigan next month to take an intensive course in English, it was announced Wednesday.

The university said Mrs. Oswald, a native of Russia, will be one of about 100 students starting special courses at the university's English Language Institute on Jan. 7. The institute spe-

cializes in teaching English to foreign students.

The director, John C. Catford, said, "We regard Mrs. Oswald as a typical institute student."

Her stay will be sponsored by the First Presbyterian Church.

A committee of church members first invited Mrs. Oswald to come to Ann Ar-

bor for the university's English course last December. The university said she expressed interest because of

her limited knowledge of English but was unable to come at an earlier date.

Mrs. Oswald has had no formal instruction in English. She graduated from a technical course in pharmacy in Leningrad before her marriage. She came to the

United States in 1962.

Catford said people from at least 12 countries will be taking the English course with Mrs. Oswald.

The university said Mrs. Oswald "had indicated a desire to continue her education and mastery of the language is a necessary preliminary to such study." **END**
