

VALUE OF TWO OSWALD GUNS SET AT \$10,000

LA-312765 DALLAS (AP) The \$12.95 rifle used to assassinate President John F. Kennedy and the pistol with which police officer J. D. Tippit was slain have been valued at \$10,000.

The weapons, owned by assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, were valued Friday by three appraisers appointed by County Probate Court.

At the same time the court named Mrs. Marina Oswald as community administrator for the property. Harry McKay, one of the appraisers, said William Blaylock, Mrs. Oswald's attorney, indicated that a \$10,000 bid for the two weapons had been made by a gun collector.

Blaylock said the weapons now are in the possession of the Department of Justice. *END*
