LONDON — (UPI) — A study on the politics of President Johnson published here yesterday said that he had failed in all his efforts to coax Mrs. John F. Kennedy into his orbit.

The Observer, a Sunday newspaper, has been carrying a series on "The Politics of L.B.J." by Michael Davie.

Yesterday's installment said that the President's

failures had been trivial but included not winning over the Kennedy family and its adherents. The article said of Johnson:

"All his efforts to coax Mrs. Kennedy into the Johnson orbit have failed; instead, a widowed queen in exile, she waits in Fifth Avenue for the restoration of the dynasty to the throne. The Kennedy family is emerging as the opposition within the Democratic Party." END.
