Hearing on Ruby Sanity to Open

DALLAS (AP)—Jack Ruby's sanity hearing is set for today but his lawyers said Sunday they will seek a delay.

Ruby, a former Dallas night club operator, has been in custody here since Nov. 24, 1963, when he shot and killed Presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald.

Dallas jurors gave Ruby the death penalty March 14, 1964.

The Texas Court of Criminal Appeals has directed that the trial court legally determine whether Ruby is sane. **END**
