## Oswald's Landlady Succumbs

DALLAS, Tex. (AP) — Earline Roberts' roomer came running in, got a coat and ran out without speaking.

He was Lee Harvey Oswald, who had just killed President John F. Kennedy.

Mrs. Roberts ran a rooming house at 1026 N. Beckley where Oswald lived as O. H. Lee and where he plotted the assassination.

Mrs. Roberts was apparently seized by a heart attack Sunday at her home, 212 W. Woodin, rushed to Parkland Hospital, and died.

"He came running like the dickens and I said to him, 'You sure are in a hurry,' but he didn't say anything — just ran in his room, got a short tan coat, and ran back out," Mrs. Roberts said of Oswald after the assassination.

She told the Dallas Morning News that Oswald "was always in bed by 9:30 or 10 p.m." In cleaning his \$8 per week room, she said she noticed that Oswald was neat, read westerns, ate a lot of fruit and made sandwiches in his room.

Mrs. Roberts, a widow, moved to Dallas from Tennessee in 1940. She was a native of Woodbury, Tenn. *ene*
