Too Much Already: At 24, MARINA OSWALD PORTER has already had one traumatic brush with violence. Her first husband, Presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, was murdered in a Texas jail. Now, after barely two months of marriage, she is claiming that her second husband, electronics technician KENNETH JESS PORTER, 27, struck her and threatened to kill himself. "He slapped me in the face and tried to get me to put the children outside," she said in an

affidavit, "so he could be alone with the gun he carried. I'm afraid he might try to do me bodily harm." By coincidence, Porter was taken to the Dallas County jail, where Jack Ruby, who shot Lee Oswald, is awaiting a retrial. The next day, Porter was freed on \$1,000 bail and he denied all the charges. "It's just time for her to have some more publicity," he said. Publicity, insisted Marina, was the last thing she wanted. And after a half-hour conference in the office of Justice of the Peace W.E. Richburg, the couple announced that they had settled their differences. "I don't want these things to happen," Marina said. "I had too much of this with Lee."
