

### Book Seen First Time by Kennedy Attorney

NEW YORK (AP)—An attorney for Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy looked at the manuscript of the book "Death of a President" for the first time Saturday.

He said he took Mrs. Kennedy along with him, but that she did not read it because she thought it would be too painful.

Simon H. Rifkind, who filed the suit on behalf of Mrs. Kennedy to block publication of the book, said he viewed the manuscript in the office of Da-

vid Peck, an attorney for Cowles.

Rifkind said he spent "many hours" looking at the manuscript. Mrs. Kennedy left the meeting before her attorney did.

Sources said she left in tears, visibly upset. Rifkind said he did not see her in tears. (AP)
