Let's see. First Jacqueline Kennedy sued Look magazine to stop publication of certain passages in William Manchester's "The Death of a President." Settled out of court. Next, Look sued The Chicago Daily News for breaking the release date on the magazine's serialization of the book. Settled out of court. Look also sued the German magazine Stern because it was publishing the passages Look had agreed to delete. Last week, Look tried on another suit—asking The New York World Journal Tribune for \$700,000 for breaking the release date. With so many suits, all parties are expected to be redressed.
