

Garrison supporters form local group

One hundred persons gathered at the UCLA Student Union Building last Saturday to organize public support for New Orleans District Attorney Garrison's investigation of the Kennedy Assassination during this Presidential election year.

Sentiment was expressed that the Warren Commission had failed in its purpose and a substantial reward should be set up for information leading to the actual killers of the President. It was

stressed that the work of the as-yet-unnamed organization had nothing to do with political action but was concerned exclusively with advocating further criminal investigation.
