World-shaking events have happened so frequently since the assassination of President Kennedy that it is extremely difficult to place them in a proper perspective. Almost every event of importance (by a strange coincidence) has involved the CIA, our super-secret spy agency.

It was this agency that caused Eisenhower's embarrassment in Paris with the shooting down of Powers in the U-2 spy plane. It was the CIA that got this nation involved in the Bay of Pigs fiasco for which Kennedy took the blame. JFK felt-and most Americans will agree - that spies are necessary in this age of power struggles-but such intelligence must be made to answer to the representatives of the American people and nevel allowed to be a government unto itself, as the CIA has now become. Kennedy once remarked that the CLA "should be broken up and scattered to the four winds."

I seriously believe, in the light of these three facts, that the CIA has played a very big part in causing the turmoil and unrest in many socialist and communist countries throughout the world. I further believe that much of this was done to detract our thoughts and attention from the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Loran Hall, a former anti-Castro right-winger (a former citizen of Haysville) has placed his life on the line and is now in hiding. While talking to his mother (who lives in Wichita) I was told that since he saw Garrison in early May he has been shot at twice.
