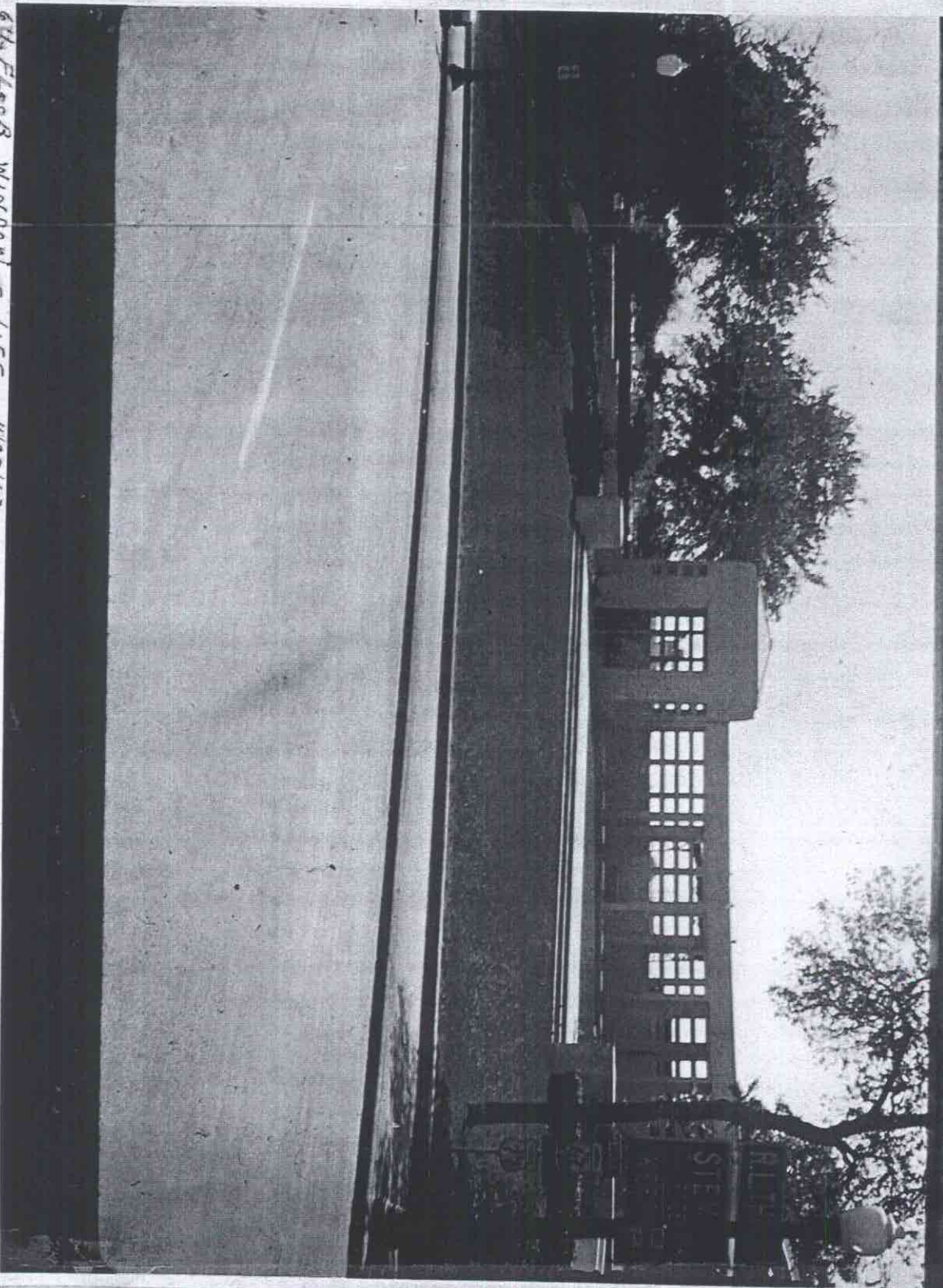


THE FILE WITHIN ROOM 1113, STUVA IN MARCH OF 1964 WITH SIGNING ON THE SAME SPOT HE WAS STANDING ON WHEN HE TOOK WILLIS EXHIBIT #1. HE HAS IDENTIFIED THAT SPOT BY MARKING IT WITH A FIGURE 511 ON THE ATTACHED VIEW OF THE SCENE FROM THE



6TH FLOOR WINDOW. - LIFE - 11/29/63.
NOTE: STEVENSON'S SIGN HAS BEEN REMOVED ENTIRELY FROM ITS ORIGINAL POSITION.
IT HAS NOW BEEN COMBINED WITH THE THORNTON SIGN.

This photograph was taken from Willis' position in March of 1965. You will note that the Stemons sign has been removed entirely from its' original position. The change was made much earlier than March, 1965, however. Look at the signs and you will see that this is the movement that Hudson was describing in his testimony of July 22, 1964, when he said: (V5-p362) "Now, they have moved some of these signs. They have moved that R. L. Thornton Freeway sign and put up a Stemons sign."
