

**RUBY SANITY TRIAL  
ORDERED TO PROCEED**

DALLAS, June 10 (UPI)—  
District Judge Louis Holland  
today ordered a sanity trial for  
Jack L. Ruby to proceed on  
schedule Monday.

Judge Holland said that if  
Ruby's attorneys did not want  
to present a case he would ap-  
point lawyers who would. How-  
ever, Ruby's attorneys indicated  
they would present witnesses.  
Ruby has been sentenced to die  
for killing Lee Harvey Oswald,  
assassin of President Kennedy.

Ruby's attorneys had  
pleaded that they could not  
meet the state's contention  
that it is sane because to  
deprive Ruby of his  
constitutional rights.  
Tomahill, a Ruby attorney,  
told Judge Holland that his  
contention is that he is insane  
and there is nothing I or  
anyone else can do about it.  
He said he would not deprive him of  
his constitutional rights.

Ruby's appeal could not be heard  
because Ruby was not in court today  
for the pre-trial hearing. The  
subject of the hearing was  
a motion by Ruby's sister, Mrs.  
Mable Ruby, withdrawing her  
plea that her brother  
was sane because she was  
accused of murder.
