

High Court Acquittal of Ruby Asked

WASHINGTON (AP) —
Counsel for Jack Ruby ap-
pealed to the Supreme
Court Friday to overturn
his conviction as the slayer
of Lee Harvey Oswald,
the assassin of President

Ruby "has not had the
most-semblance of
a trial," the appeal said.
Ruby was sentenced by
a state court in Dallas
on March 14, 1964, to execu-
tion.
The Texas Civil Lib-
erties Union and a group
of private attorneys filed the
appeal, basing it on the
