



Photographs have played a key role in the controversy over the Warren Commission's report. Picture at upper left, reportedly snapped by Marina Oswald, shows Lee Harvey Oswald with his arsenal. The doubters say the photo is a fake because the shadows on Oswald's face and body appear to be cast from different directions. Bottom picture raises more doubt

about Oswald as the assassin, for it shows a man (circled) who appears to be Oswald, on the street at the time the shots were fired. A man named Peabody claims to be the person pictured. Picture at upper right is taken with a camera mounted on a gunsight and shows what an assassin located on the sixth floor of the book depository would have been able to see.

No Rest, Peace For John Kennedy

Sequence of pictures from a filmstrip taken by Abraham Zapruder, a Dallas dress manufacturer, shows John F. Kennedy talking to his wife, being hit, Mrs. Kennedy climbing over the hood of the car for help, and an FBI agent pushing her back into the car as it speeds up to go to Parkland Hospital, where the President died. Film has been near the center of storm surrounding the Warren Commission's findings.
