

Hart Would Oppose Inquiry
 WASHINGTON, Nov. 20 (AP)—Senator Philip A. Hart, Democrat of Michigan, said today that he was completely satisfied with the Warren Commission report on the assassination of President Kennedy three days ago.

Senator Hart said in an interview that he would oppose any Congressional investigation of the assassination.

"We should let this one rest now with the press and the historians," he said, and added: "I think the caliber of the men who composed that commission insures that the verdict, the general verdict is sound. I have no reason to think that the Warren Commission report fails to answer the question: 'What happened in Dallas?'"
