Death Ruby, 36, underwent daily examinations at Parkland Hospital in Dallas as physicians sought the source of the malignant tumor found Saturday in a lymph node in his neck. Although some medical sources were pessimistic, Dr. Jay Sanford, who is examining Ruby, said it was not necessarily a hopeless case and his chances of recovery depend on the location of the primary site.

The doctor said Ruby certainly would not be physically ready in the next couple of months to stand his second trial for the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald, the assassin of President John F. Kennedy.
