**B.B.C. to Spend Evening  
On Assassination Doubt**  
*NY 1/26/67*  
 LONDON (UPI) Jan. 25  
 The British Broadcasting  
 Corporation announced today  
 that it would devote an en-  
 tire evening of prime broad-  
 cast time to a television in-  
 quiry into the doubts sur-  
 rounding the assassination  
 of President Kennedy.  
 It was the first time the  
 B.B.C. had ever set aside an  
 entire evening — 4½ hours  
 for a single program. The  
 program, entitled "The Death  
 of Kennedy," will be shown  
 Sunday, Jan. 29.  
 Mark Lane's film of his  
 book "Rush to Judgment,"  
 which contends that others  
 were involved in the assas-  
 sination and that Lee Har-  
 vey Oswald was framed, will  
 be shown publicly for the  
 first time in the program.  
 So far it has been shown  
 only to private groups.  
 Mr. Lane will appear live  
 during the program.  
 A 300-square-foot model  
 of the site of the assassina-  
 tion will be shown. *END*
