

(AP) - Marie Tippit, widow of Dallas police officer slain in 1963 by Lee Harvey Oswald, and Police Lieut. Harry Thomas confirmed yesterday that they were married a week ago at the Beck Baptist Church. Mrs. Tippit has five children ranging from 8 to 15 years in age. J. D. Tippit was slain shortly after President Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas Nov. 23, 1963. Oswald was also named by the Warren Commission as the assassin of the President. During the months following the assassination, Mrs. Tippit received thousands of letters including money donations. The final total was \$7,579, on which she was ordered to pay no income tax. A judge authorized about \$100,000 of it for a trust fund for the Tippit children. The widow received most of the
