Oswald Nor Alone, Says Investigator

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. (AP)—Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison said today an investigatif by an office shows the W refi Commission report is accurate in stating that Le Harvey Oswald acted along in the assassination of President Kennedy

Garrison refused to elaborate.

The district attorney said his investigation was begun to determine the possibility of an assassination conspiracy in New Orleans.

Garrison said his investigat tors have uncovered facts which "are interesting."

PREVIOUSLY SILENT Previously, Garrison has refused to commend on a copyrighted story about his investigation which appearent in yesterday's New Orleans States-Item.

He said a prisoner in the Ofleans Parish jail now possibly has his life in jeopardy as a result of the publicity given the probe. He did not name the prisoner.

The States Item said Mi guel Torres, a 26-year-old Cu ban who formerly lived only a block from Oswald's last known New Orleans address was brought from the Louisa ha State Prison at Angola to the Orleans parish jail om Jan. 30.

3 PRISON SENTENCES

Torres, the account said, is serving three concurrent nineyear terms for burghries and "he is known to be connected with the DA's nvestigation."

At the news conference Garrison was questione about William Manches er's book, "Death of the President," in chich the thor says Oswald acted alone.

"Manchester wasn't the at the assassination," say Garrison. "Neither was I, but my office has spent consider able more time investigating the assassination than Mas chester did and it is my halief that man was wrong."
