Ferrie Appears In Warren Report

WASHINGTON, Feb. 22 (UPI)—David William Ferrie figures in four pages of the Warren Commission report in which investigators sought to determine if he had any connection with presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald. They were unable to pin down any such connection.

The questioning centered around whether Ferrie was in charge of a Civil Air Patrol unit at the same time Oswald became associated with it.

Two witnesses, Edward Voebel, a New Orleans florist, and Frederick S. O'Sullivan, a member of the vice squad of the New Orleans Police Department, both failed to provide a link between Ferrie and Oswald.

Ferrie himself was not questioned, according to the published volumes of the Warren Commission report.

O'Sullivan stated flatly that he knew of no connection between Ferrie and Oswald. Voebel said he didn't remember if they were even in the CAP unit at the same time. **END**
