Marguerite Oswald claims the
defendants made false and misleading statements about her
and her son, who was named
by the Warren Commission as
the rifleman who shot President
John F. Kennedy.

One petition names Rep. Gerald R. Ford, R-Mich., along with John R. Stiles and Simor & Schuster Inc. Ford was a member of the Warren Commission and wrote a book about its probe of the Kennedy assassination Nov. 22, 1963, in Dallas. The other four libel suits are
