Only one more juror remains to be selected for the trial in New Orleans of Clay L. Shaw, accused by Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison of conspiring to assassinate President John F. Kennedy. Meanwhile, former Texas Gov. John B. Connally said he would testify before the Shaw jury only if ordered to do so by a Texas court. Connally, wounded while riding in the presidential limousine when the assassination occurred in Dallas, Nov. 22, 1963, and his wife were subpoenaed Tuesday by Garrison's office.
