CONNALLY TESTIMONY DELAYED BY GARRISON

NEW ORLEANS (AP)—
Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's
prosecution team abruptly
switched signals Sunday
and delayed calling former
Texas Gov. John B. Con-
nally as a witness at the
trial of Clay L. Shaw,
charged with conspiring
to assassinate President
John F. Kennedy.

Connally and his wife
had been subpoenaed to
appear today.

The uncertainty sur-
rounding this move left it

unclear whether the Con-
nallys would testify at all
in the New Orleans trial.
Connally was wounded se-
riously in the Kennedy
assassination Nov. 22,
1963, in Dallas.

"There is really nothing
I can tell you," said Asst.
Dist. Atty. William Alford,
who is handling the assas-
sination phase of Garri-
son's conspiracy case.
When asked if the Connal-
lys might not appear at all,
he said, "I can't comment
on that."
