Clay L. Shaw, acquitted March 1 of conspiring to kill President John F. Kennedy, pleaded innocent to charges that he perjured himself during his trial in New Orleans. His attorneys were given until April 28 to file pleadings in the case. Shaw is accused by Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison of lying in his trial testimony when he said he had not known Lee Harvey Oswald or David Ferrie, both now dead.
