

Eld^{L A T and}est Brother of Sirhan Hit, Injured by Car D-25-19

Saidallah Bishara Sirhan, 36, the eldest brother of the man on trial for the murder of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy, was struck by an automobile on a Pasadena street Thursday and was reported in serious condition in a hospital, police said.

Sirhan Bishara Sirhan's brother was crossing Lake Ave. in a crosswalk at Howard St. about 6:35 p.m. when he was struck by an automobile driven by Murray A. Williams, 18, of 266 W. Ventura St., Altadena, police said.

Williams, a Pasadena City College student on his way to school, was not held, police reported.

Saidallah Sirhan was taken to St. Luke's Hospital in Pasadena where doctors reported that he had a possible skull fracture and a broken right leg. His condition was reported as serious. 2/1
