

A hearing on a motion to dismiss perjury charges against Clay L. Shaw was continued indefinitely in state court until New Orleans Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison, who was reported ill, can testify. Two days after Shaw's acquittal March 1, 1969, on charges he conspired to murder President John F. Kennedy, Garrison charged him with lying on the witness stand.
