

Photographer of John Kennedy Shooting Dies

DALLAS (AP)—Abraham Zapruder, the only person who made motion pictures of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, died Sunday of cancer. He was 66.

Zapruder had stationed himself along the route of the Kennedy motorcade in 1963 and filmed the action when gunfire cracked near a downtown underpass.

Zapruder's film was considered highly valuable to experts trying to establish exactly how Mr. Kennedy was killed.

Zapruder owned a dress-manufacturing business.
