Arrested: SAIDALLAH SIRHAN, 38, older brother of convicted assassin Sirhan Sirhan; on a charge of public intoxication, on a highway about 15 miles from Wrightwood, Calif., Oct. 27. The California Highway Patrol received a report that a car was dangling from the edge of a cliff along the remote desert road. According to a policeman who sped to the scene, Sirhan and another man had managed to get out of the car before it plunged into a canyon. The officer said that Sirhan was sitting in the middle of the highway and had to be carried into the patrol car, where he came to life and kicked the radio out of commission.

■ JOHN LARRY RAY, 37, younger brother of convicted assassin James Earl Ray; in connection with a \$53,000 bank holdup in suburban St. Louis, Oct. 26. Jack Ray, an ex-tavern manager with a criminal record, is alleged to have driven a car that three bandits used in their getaway. "He even listed James Earl Ray as his brother on our booking sheet," said a deputy sheriff.
