ABRAHAM ZAPRUDER, 66, the only person to film the assassination of President John F. Kennedy—a fifteen-second, 8-mm. color sequence sold to Life magazine for an initial sum of \$25,000; of cancer, in Dallas, Aug. 30.

■ J.E. (Bill) Decker, 71, sheriff of Dallas County for 21 years and a living legend as a lawman; of emphysema, in Dallas, Aug. 29. Among Decker's prisoners were mass murderer Richard Speck and the killer of Lee Harvey Oswald, lack Ruby. But Decker's most celebrated case was the 1934 ambush of Clyde Barrow and Bonnie Parker. Asked how he knew their whereabouts, Decker replied: "Somebody told me."
