Dear Gary Mack

Some two months or so ago I was informed by Harold Weisberg that he had passed on to you my request for help in acquiring copies of the Mary Moorman photo. I am also very interested in any other photos you may be able to provide me with relating to the assassination of President Kennedy, especially copies of the Altgens photo and the 'magic bullet' in profile.

To date I have not heard from you, and I would like to know if you are able to help or not with a copy of the Moorman photo. If you are not able to get a copy to me I shall have to try elsewhere. (Do you have any suggestions?)

I have a couple of local newspapers interested in taking copy from me for publication to mark the thirtieth anniversary of the assassination. I have very few photos dealing with the assassination and the few I have were given to me by Harold Weisberg (I have already used them as illustrations in the two articles I have had published so far).

Most of what I know about the assassination, and the official cover up, I have learnt through my correspondence with Harold Weisberg. We have been exchanging letters for the last two years. He has very generously taken the time to answer a long string of questions that I could not find answers to in the many books I have now read on the subject.

I am a history teacher, I stick to facts, and I hold no wild (or modest) theories on what happened in Dealey Plaza thirty years ago. Harold Weisberg will vouch for me if you feel the need to check my bona fides.
