Dear Harold

Hello, and a <sup>"</sup>Happy New Year<sup>"</sup> to you both! I cannot accept it yet, that today is already the third day of 1994.

This will only be a very short postscript to my last letter. I left a couple of important questions out, as you will see;

1. Was there ever any 'evidence' that the two bullet fragments picked up from the floor of the presidential limousine on the night of the 22nd November 1963 back in Washington had traces of blood or tissue or hair or anything which would connect them with Kennedy? I know I could go to your books and look this sort of thing up, but I am really asking if there is anything, generally or specifically, not in your books in reference to this matter you could tell me. And I would like to know what you think the the significance was/is of this evidence.
2. When were the changes made to Dealey Plaza, resurfacing of the road which necessitated repainting the white lines along Elm Street, and replacing (and repositioning) the road signs? 3. Do you have any lecture notes from your classes at Hood College you could let me read? I would feel a lot happier teaching something on the JFK assassination if I could be guided by the parameters you have set for your own work at Hood College. I am afraid unless I am very careful I could run off at a tangent into speculation, either my own or somebody else's. As much as I can I would wish to keep my course proposal firmly rooted in fact, as you have shown me.

In case you are wondering at my timeframe, it would probably not be until next year before I could start, assuming my proposal to run such a course was approved. I would like to look at starting something later in the year, in the second semester, but that may be too, optimistic. These things take time to get approved and registered and then advertised. I would be grateful too if you would run your eye over my course proposal before I submitted it. Any help you could provide later in the area of content, maybe using copies of some of your documents, would also be a tremendous help. End of page, I am in haste as usual, must go.
