July '61 - First Bull Run

Feb. '62 Fall of Ft. Henry

Army of Potomac--On to Richmond

Feb. 15/16th Fall of Ft.
Donaldson. (Generals Floyd and Pillow abandon their commands. Takes the glow off of First Bull Run

April 4/5 '62 Battle of Shiloh ; Nashvile abandoned

May/June '62 Jackson's aba.
Valley Campaigns. He completely outmaneuvered
3 separate Union armies; won four battles;
and made monkies out of Banks, Fremont, and McDowell;
tizing up 60,000 Union troops.

April 27th--Fall of New Orleans

June/July '62 The Seven
Days Battle. The CSA broke the
seige of Richmond

May '62 Corinth abandoned

August '62 SecondManassas.

June '62 Fall of Memphis

Summer begins the seige of Vicksburg. By the summer the CSA controlled only 200 miles of Mississippi.

After Second Manassas, Lee was high on the invincibility of his Army of Virginia.
