Barksdale, Senator Byrd's sa member on research and speech writing. Senator Bard outlined to re his responsibilities in the supervision of the district of Coluchia Government. Le told ce h extremely concerned over the pronouncements made recently by Mart Luther Kirs that massive civit disobccience yould be staged in the mation of capital this summer. The Senator indicated it was time King "met his Vaterloo" and that he felt this surfer would do the trick. He finited this, of course, depended upon whether or not the President would allow sufficient force to "knock King down." Senator Byrd asked me if the YBI could prepare a speech for him on the subject of King which he could give on the Senate floor maxt week. "He stated thereafter he would like to be kept up to date on the activities of King so that further speeches could } made. He reminded me that he was a great supporter of Hr. Hoover the 721. He reiterated his responsibilities in connection with th D.C. Government and told me that, while other scnators and congres were aiding and abetting the alleged civil rights cause, he had co stantly sounded forth a warning as to the attachments to subversiv causes which many so-called civil rights leaders had. I told Senator Byrd and Zr. Barksdale that, while we ap ciated his great interest, the pressure of work yould present us i being of assistance and we, therefore, could not propare the speec he had in mind. I stated if any items of a public source mature c to our attention which we felt would be of interest to the Schator could, of course, refer him to the appropriate source which contain lthese itens. . .
