- I. The FBI's Vendetta Against King--to destroy him and his movement.
- A. Hoover's rampant racism. Before there was King there were the Director of the FBI. For example, in the 1940s the Hoover Bureau placed the NAACP under FBI surveillance because Hoover could not believe that blacks were intelligent enough to organize and articulate their grievances on their own, therefore the NAACP had to be a front for the CPUSA. A tool of the Kremlin. Even in the 1960s when some of his top intelligence people urged him to drop the surveillance on the NAACP because it was wasting precious manpower, the Director insisted that he was right and that his agents were simply not clever enough in detecting the quiding hand of the Communist manipulators, etc.
 - B. Vendetta directed against King.

King interested Hoover during the Montgomery boycott of the 1950s. But it appears that it was the 1963 March on Washington where King gave his "I Have A Dream" speech that convinced the Director that the civil rights movement in general and King and the SCLC, in particular, would not wither away, and that he and his agency would have to destroy King and his movement before it destroyed the Director's dream of what American was supposed to be all about. Hoover viewed the civil rights movement as a threat to his way of life, his bureau cracy, and his vision of a white, Christain, and harmonious America.

- 1. Hoover, King, and Stanly Levison.
