Basic question? What role, if any, did/Kin the FBI play in the King assassination.

No evidence that Hoover FBI had any thing to do with the shooting. No evidence that the Bureau (none made public)knew of any conspiracy against his life. We are to remember that the FBI's COINTELPRO against King continued right up until his death. Had they known of any conspiracy or were apart of a conspiracy they would have dropped their harrassment (or at least one could make this argument). Why tie themselves to the King assassination by leaving a trail of doumentary evidence that they were out to "break" him, etc.

But did the FBI play any role in forcing King to return to Memphis and help create a climate that would raise the risks of his assassination?
