Dear Jerry,

Thanks for your letter. I got a chuckle out of your imaginative account of the kind of reaction I would likely get from "Waffle" (i.e., Wofford) students to my assigning those guide questions on Never Again!. I have not had any open, direct confrontations (or death threats) yet, but I can read the silent expressions on the faces of many which I would guess are close to your account. Reading books seems to be about the last thing on the minds of most students, especially these days with such easy access to all the wonderful bits and pieces of "information" on the Internet. Surprisingly, however, I have gotten a few sets of responses which were quite good. The due date for #s 28-116 is this Friday, our last day of classes.

The primary reason I am responding so soon to your letter is to correct a few minor errors I have detected:

- * there is no question #8
- * Question #26: the page on which the answer is found is 63, not 62.
- * Question #55: the word not should read note.
- * Question #75: the page on which the answer is found is 259, not 262.
- * Question #99: the page on which the answer is found is 381-382, not just 381.
- * Finally, you might want to include FOIA among the abbreviations I identify at the beginning.

There are some questions that are repetitious, but that may help to reinforce certain points.
