Q104 One 30' roll of 8mm Kodachrome movie film with container bearing customer's name "Robert Hughes" bearing exposures of the Texas Schoolbook Depository Building from which assassin fired the gun killing President John F. Kennedy, 11/22/63

Result of examination:

There are no images in any of the exposures of Q104 which show the corner window of the sixth floor of the Texas Schoolbook Depository Building from which the assassin's gun was fired that can be interpreted as the form of an individual. The forms recorded in this window can be interpreted as in the same general shapes of boxes, found at and just behind the window in question.

Specimen Q104 is being retained.
