Eisenberg: Can you explain what the procedure  
is when a document comes in involving  
the assassination?

Cadogan Initially, the <sup>batch</sup> ~~first~~ batch of  
evidence was brought into the  
laboratory on Nov. 23 of 1963 and

Eisenberg 1963? Consisted of many, many items

Cadogan: Nov. 23, 1963. It was a large  
quantity of evidence (was ~~not~~ edited  
cover) Version?

Check with Laboratory.

Eisenberg asked about ~~the~~ specific item

Cadigan. Only, insofar, that I know <sup>195</sup> that on  
Nov. 23, when the vast bulk of this material  
came in, that it was photographed. Some of these  
items — — — . But the exact sequence to  
select one item out of four or five hundred,
