Bullet recovered from stretcher in hospital by Secret service, two bullet fragments recovered from President's automobile of Secret Service and two cartridge cases delivered to Laboratory of BA DRAIN, your office, identified as being fired by submitted so millimeter Mannlicher-Carcano rifle delivered by SA DRAIN. Sweral black cotton, orange yellow cotton, and gray black cotton ibers which matched similar fibers composing OSFALD's shirt recoved from butt plate of submitted rifle. So fibers found on guantiche could be associated with green blanket. Single brown viscose iber and several light green cotton fibers which match similar ibers present in composition of green blanket found on paper bug otton fibers from gun are same colors as cotton fibers composing hirt; however, due to limited number of colors in shirt (3), not cossible to state shirt is positively source of these fibers.

Identification Division determined that latent prints appearing in photograph taken of the rifle of Dallas Police Dept. too fragmentary and indistinct to be of any value for identification purposes. Similar photo taken by Buranu also failed to produce prints of sufficient legibility for comparison purposes. Latent fingerprints developed by identification Division on brown paper bag recovered at scene and marked Found mext to 6th floor window pun fired from may have been used to carry gun. Lt. J. C. DAY also identified with left index finger impression of LKE HARVEY of the addition, one latent palm print developed on paper bag identified with right palm print of OSVALD.

No latent prints of value developed on the revolver, cartridge cases,, clip, inner parts of rifle or unfired cartridge.
