

Notes with Lovelady/Oswald Pixs.

Picture of Lovelady with the shirt he was wearing on day of the assassination.

Story line: Picture was taken by Robert Richter of CBS TV in 1967.

He asked Hal want to look for when he went to Dallas to prepare for a CBS special on the JFK assassination. Hal suggested a picture of Lovelady and the shirt he was wearing on the day of the assassination. This is the picture of the shirt. It was staged other than in front of the TSBD.

Hal showed him the Altgen's film of Lovelady from WW II. He suggested that Richter get LL to pose in the same shirt as depicted in that Altgen's picture.

Richter sent a copy of the picture to Hal in 1967.

Later, Hal went to the Dallas Cinema Association or Associates. (This is cited in WW III or WW II). They had a shot taken by John Martin of the doorway to the TSBD but it was overexposed. He asked Carl Groden to examine the Martin film to see if he could isolate any shot of Oswald and Lovelady on the day of the assassination. Groden found one of Lovelady wearing the shirt that Richter has him wearing in 1967. None of Oswald was found.
