Dear Jim:

The President's Commission requested that the TBI Laboratory conduct an examination of the windshield from the Presidential limousine to determine whether cracks in the viposhicld were caused by an object striking the glass from in front of the vahicle or behind the vehicle.

On March 10. 1964, the vinishield was obtained from the White House Carego and the requested exculastions were conducted.

The vindshield is laminated safety glass which consists of two pieces of glass bonded together by a piestic interlayer.

The windshield has been struck by an object at the point at which the cracks in the glass join. This point is within an area circled in red on the windshield. The cracks which radiate from this point are present only in the outer layer of glass. Minute fragments of glass are alsoing from the outside surface of the outer layer of glass at the confluence of the cracks. In addition, strapings which were previously obtained from the inside surface of the windshield in the insediate area of the point of import were proviously identified as lead.

Then lastisated glass is struck, the piece of glass opposite the side of impact is put into a state of tension

which results in cracks in the glass opposite the side of impact. These cracks radiate from the point of impact.

It was therefore concluded that the cracks resulted from the windshield having been struck from the inside; that is, from the rear of the vehicle.

The results of the above examinations have been furnished to the President's Commission.

On March 25, 1964, the windshield was returned to the White House Garage.
