

Dr. Vincent P. Guinn, head of the Neutron Activation Amalyses Section of General Atomic Division, General Dynamics Corporation, San Diego, California, and his associates have been studying methods of detection of powder residues by neutron activation analyses for the past few years. They have received contracts from the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) to conduct research on this matter. Until the assassination of President Kennedy all their research work was conducted on residues left from the firing of hand weapons.

Today Dr. Vincent P. Guinn called the FHI Laboratory and speke to SA John F. Gallagher. His call was incoming from Chicago, Illinois. He advised that since the assessination a large part of their offorts have been directed to the determination of powder residues on paraffin casts taken from the hands and checks of individuals who have whot a rifle similar to the one reportedly owned by Lee Harvey Oswald. He advised that there appears that triple firing of this rifle will leave unambiguous positive tests every time on the paraffin casts. It further appears that washing the casts with diphenylbenzidine does remove one of the characteristic elements (barium) but such washings do not remove all of the other characteristic element/in powder residues (antimony).

Porther be advised that the tests to date indicate that powder residues are deposited on both chocks of the shooter after the rifle is fired either one time or three times.

It appears, he added, that these results can be obtained even if the paraffin casts are made 2; hours after shooting the rifle providing that the skin of the shooter had not been washed in the meantime.
