IN ORDER TO ANSWER FULLY CERTAIN ALLEGATIONS IN BOOK, YOU SHOULD ADVISE OF PERTINENT INFORMATION PREVIOUSLY REPORTED AND IF NECESSARY CONDUCT ANY APPROPRIATE INQUIRY TO OBTAIN COMPLETE FACTS RE ALLEGATIONS. EXPEDITE AND SUTEL.

GUN ALSO ALLEGES THAT WALTHERS WAS AMONG THE POLICEMEN ARRIVING AT THE TEXAS THEATER AT THE TIME OF OSWALD'S ARREST.
