NOTE: Commission by relet advised that Mrs. Earlene Roberts, the housekeeper at 1026 North Beckley, Dallas, Texas, where Oswald resided at the time of the assassination, had reported that at about 1:00 p.m., on 11-22-63, Dallas ; olice car Number 207 drove slowly by the front of her premises and honked the horn several times. The Dallas FD indicated that car 207 was not in the vicinity at this time.

The Commission requests appropriate investigation to determine if any Dallas police <u>cars</u> were in the vicinity of the premises between the hours of 12:00 noon and 2:00 p.m., <u>cars</u> on 11-22-63.
