Harold Feldman "The Grassy Knoll" . . .piece in Minority of One (March 1965) Includes accounts of 121 people on the shots/origins. . .Worth reviewing\*\*\*\*\* Can make point he makes: WC dismissed the 51 witnesses who said shots came from other location than TSBD. . .Of the 20 deputy sheriffs some thought shots came from the grassy knoll . . .Make case that eye and ear witnesses in police cases are the least credible in these situations but deputy sheriffs are more trained. . .
2. Connally's account of the shooting. Rosen to Belmont 12/13/'63 109060-1991 (section 27). Nothing essential here. . .
3. Witness statements/no great value. . .
4. Statements by SS and FBI agents/nothing striking. .
5. Dallas Times piece 11/22/'63 on shooting.. .
6. NY Times 11/28/'63 interview w/ Connally; attached is SS Howlett statement about the shooting. . . this will be consistent with FBI
7. FBI report on Rowland and sitting black man . . .
8. SS Landis account of shooting.. .
9. Newspaper piece 11/26/'63 NY Times piece by John Herbers cites Dr. Kemp Clark that a bullet struck JFK in the front in his neck and "ranged downward in his chest and did not exit."
